FLORAL SECTION RULES/GUIDELINES

- 1 An “exhibit” comprises natural plant material with or without accessories, contained within a space given in the Schedule.
- 2 All exhibits must be the **unaided** work of the competitor.
- 3 ALL Exhibits may be created off-site and staged (presented for judging) in the exhibition hall.
- 4 Exhibits presented for judging **MUST** be staged by 10am on the day of judging and entrants are to vacate the hall by that time.
- 5 All measures are approximate.
- 6 All exhibits must be staged within the space provided.
- 7 No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit in a numbered class of the Foral Section.
- 8 Fresh plant material to predominate in all classes.

- 9 Any additional backgrounds or drapes must be self-supporting. No pins or accessories to be attached to the niches or display spaces.
- 10 Accessories should be in scale and not dominate plant material.
- 11 All exhibits will be judged from the front, the judges may look at the sides if they are visible.
